Carol Marin has earned impeccable credentials as an investigative reporter and TV anchor since she began her career in Chicago in 1978. She is now the political editor for WMAQ-TV, Channel 5, in Chicago and a political columnist for the *Chicago Sun-Times*. Ms Marin is President and CEO of her own production company, Marin Corp Productions, and the co-director of the DePaul Documentary Project. Since January 2006, she has hosted discussions twice a week on PBS's *Chicago Tonight* about local issues and news stories, conducting interviews with Chicago's newsmakers.

Ms Marin worked as a correspondent for CBS News from 1997-2002 and has appeared on news programs such as *60 Minutes*, *60 Minutes II*, *The CBS Evening News with Dan Rather*, and *48 Hours*.

She has been highly acclaimed for her hard-hitting political and investigative journalism that focuses on government, political and judicial corruption, and organized crime. Carol Marin has been honored with many prestigious awards during her illustrious career: two George Foster Peabody awards, two National Emmy awards, two Alfred I. duPont Columbia University awards, the Gracie Award from American Women in Radio and Television, and the National UPI Reporter of the Year Award.

Illinois Dunesland Preservation Society is grateful that Carol Marin is investigating and examining the claims that Dunesland has made for many years about the very serious asbestos contamination on the Illinois shoreline. This public health disaster has been covered-up by the government officials who chose not to enforce environmental rules and regulations and dumped additional pollutants themselves. Then, they co-authored "rigged" reports while telling the public the studies were independent and that the beaches are "safe" to visit.
